

MENTORING CHALLENGE

PURPOSE: To promote the leadership of older participants in the mentoring of younger participants.

PROCESS:

Each participant will:

- Complete all requirements below by **two weeks** before MWLTC convention.
- Submit all Mentoring Challenge submission material to the event coordinator on one submission form no later than the Challenge Event Deadline (approx two weeks before MWLTC convention). (See below for items to include in the submission.)
- Complete the Mentoring Challenge Report & Certification Form and give to Church Coordinator to sign.

The church coordinator will will:

- Certify the participant has successfully completed the requirements of this event with the Mentoring Challenge Certification Form.
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GUIDELINES:

Eligibility Requirements

- Only students in grades 9-12 are eligible to participate in this event.

Project Requirements

- A student participating in Mentoring Challenge must mentor and work with students in grades 3-6 in their training for the MWLTC Convention.
- The participant must meet with these students for a minimum of six sessions.
- The participant will coach or co-coach a team event or three individuals preparing for an individual event. The teen may work with an adult, but must take a major Mentoring role in the training. No more than two teens may work together with one team.
- The participant will work under the guidance of the Church Coordinator who will certify completion of this event. The Church Coordinator may further define these requirements for their local congregation.

Submission Requirements

- Project material must be submitted to the Mentoring Challenge event coordinator **no later the Challenge Event Deadline** before MWLTC Convention.
 - The project material may be submitted via email. It is strongly recommended that the participant request email confirmation that the event coordinator has received the project material. (A Microsoft Word version of the forms is available on the website.)
 - Submissions must include the following items:
 - a. Personal bio (high school student who helped the younger students) (one paragraph is sufficient)
 - b. Mentoring Challenge Report & Certification Form (see page 2) with all fields completed.
 - c. Digital picture(s) of each participant (include both the older and younger students) during the event process
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AWARDS:

A recognition plate will be awarded for completion of this event.
